As we have now settled students into daily learning routines, we want to provide you with information about student evaluations and when reports will be sent home over the course of the 2020-2021 school year.

### **Kindergarten Students**

Report cards for our Kindergarten students (known as Kindergarten progress reports) will be sent home with students attending school in-person on November 20. For families with children pursuing remote-learning programs, the progress reports will be mailed home on or close to that date.

### **Student in Grades 1 to 8**

Progress reports for students in Grades 1-8 will be sent home with students attending school in-person on November 11 and mailed home to all remote-learning students on or close to that date.

At any point, should you have questions or concerns regarding your child's progress, please connect with your classroom teacher. We encourage our staff to have open and ongoing communications with parents/guardians.

As well, please be aware that in light of the community health challenges posed by COVID-19 that could interrupt key events that are scheduled province-wide for all schools, the Ministry of Education has cancelled EQAO Assessments for Grade 3 and Grade 6 for the 2020-2021 school year.

We want to thank our students and parents/guardians for their outstanding efforts to adapt to the new routines of enhanced hygiene practices at our schools, [participating in daily health screening](#), and your overall support as we continue to navigate what it means to operate schools during a global pandemic.
